



Greetings 7th and 8th grade band students and parents; welcome to the 2025-2026 school year! One of our goals is to go practically paperless so we will be communicating through our weekly newsletter and Canvas.

Basic Band Fast Facts

- **Band Information Sheet** - We need all families to scan the QR code and fill out our required band information sheet.

- **Band classes** - 7th and 8th grade band students are divided into 2 different classes. Students will be divided into the Advanced band and the Intermediate Band. Both classes will perform at concerts, have trip opportunities, and will learn the same basic techniques, however, the Advanced group is open to the most proficient students who have demonstrated the ability to perform more difficult music. Instrumentation is a consideration for this class and private lessons are recommended to help students stay on pace.



Grading Policy

- 30% Performance Attendance (Concerts, performances, etc.)
- 20% Practice Records (due Mondays) - parent initials needed
- 20% Weekly assignments on Canvas
- 30% Participation (daily grade – includes having these items in class every day: **instrument** (sticks or mallets for percussionists), **music and binder**, at least three working reeds (clarinets and saxophones), at least two working reeds and a water canister (double reeds) and a **pencil**).

Concert Schedule – all dates are for 7th & 8th grade bands. Cut away this portion to post on your calendar or refrigerator!

All performances are considered mandatory participation and are graded events. It is impossible to have a truly successful performance unless each member is in attendance. Therefore, we always give advance notice for performances so all members can arrange their calendars accordingly. Please do not schedule appointments or make out-of-town trips when a performance is scheduled! Tickets are \$5 per family member, but are free for Band booster members.

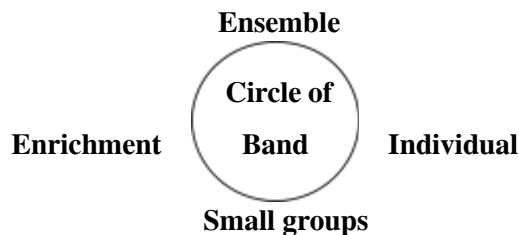
Optional events-students are eligible to participate in District Honor, All County, and All State bands based on audition.

Practice Records... are part of Student Grades! This is part of why our bands sound so good every year. Students start recording minutes on Mondays and end with Sunday and are accepted with parent signature to verify the time was met. Please help your student to write the time down as they do it, rather than try to "remember" on Sunday night. Some families keep the practice record up on the fridge for easy access and a good reminder. Students will write down how many minutes they practice daily and the goal is to show **100** minutes of total weekly practice time. Practice time should be primarily on days that students do not have band class.

Binder and Music

We will be using the provided band binder daily. For 8th graders, supplemental information will be given out to be included in the binder. If the binder has too much wear from last year it can be replaced with a new 1/2" white binder. **7th grade** will also be using the Tradition of Excellence Book 2 - it's blue. Music books can be purchased from Amazon, Music and Arts online, or JWPepper.com.

Instrument Repair

If a student's instrument is being repaired, **please bring a note signed by a parent** and make every effort to secure a "loaner" instrument from the repair store to be used until the instrument is returned. Students will need to use their own mouthpiece for the loaner instrument until their instrument is finished with repairs. Students will still be expected to participate in class while repairs are occurring.

Honor Band

The Cuthbertson Honor Band will meet after school on Thursdays from 4:15-5:30 and before school on Fridays from 8:00-8:50. This elite group will be made up of students from all grades and due to specific instrumentation needs, will be by invitation only. Interested students will submit an audition the first week of school and selected students will receive an invitation the second week of school. Rehearsals will begin September 18th.

Professional Instruction

Sessions are held once a week in 30 minute sessions taught by professionals on the instrument. Lessons are designed to help students play at a higher level, to learn additional techniques or get extra help, to achieve honor band placements, and/or work on Solo and Ensemble performances. Students may sign up individually or share a lesson with another student of similar ability. *Many parents have found that enrolling their child in private lessons pays back when they receive college scholarships.* **Sign ups are happening now!**

Free Melodies

This is once a week, free 30 minute tutoring sessions run by our high school students is designed to give enrichment for beginning to mid-level students. Free Melodies will be held on Tuesdays starting in November.

Band Booster Organization

We have a wonderful group of band parents that support that band and have made communication a top priority. There have two main sources of information:

- Weekly Band Blast emails. We have lists for high school and middle school families.
- Facebook- We have a group titled Cuthbertson Bands Parents/Guardians. Please answer all of the membership questions. This group is for parents/guardians only, no students or extended family please. We use the FB page to post things that cannot wait for the weekly band blast, as well as travel information when our bands travel to performances, so we take security of this page seriously.
- Our band booster organization partners with Levy Restaurants to work a concessions stand at the Bank of America stadium for the NFL, CLT FC, and Concert Series each year. We are able to raise around \$20,000 annually to support the MS and HS concert programs, and add additional events to support the extracurricular ensembles and some travel. Every volunteer shift raises about \$200, and each event raises about \$1500. This is easy money and a great way to fundraise without leaning on our circles to donate money. All we need is your time- if every family volunteers for 2 concession shifts, we'd have more than enough people to fulfill our obligation.
